## TICKETS & BOARDING BOATS AT LOCH LOMOND SHORES

Enjoy free car parking at Loch Lomond Shores.

Buy tickets for the Circular and Balloch / Balmaha services at the Gateway Centre Loch Lomond shores.

Buy Tickets on board from other points and for Luss / Balmaha service.

The five minute walk from the Gateway Centre to the waterbus boarding point is signposted. The circular route embarks from the shore at Drumkinnon bay, the Balloch / Balmaha service embarks from the pontoon at the Duncan Mills Memorial Slipway. The slipway pontoon can be very busy with people launching boats so you will be directed to a waiting area and escorted onto the waterbus. While on the pontoon you will be required to wear a buoyancy aid (these will be provided).

There is NO parking at Duncan Mills Memorial slipway for waterbus passengers.

Boarding points at other locations are clearly signposted.

**Reduced Mobility passengers.** Whilst we welcome disabled passengers, please be aware that the vessels on the Balloch- Balmaha- Luss service were built some time ago and there are no special facilities onboard for disabled passengers. The circular service vessel is DDA compliant however access to the boat is across the beach. Please contact the operators for more information.
